



**Walter (Buzz) Stewart, PhD, MPH, Vice President, Chief Research Officer, Sutter Health**

Buzz joined Sutter in July, 2012 to launch and lead a new division of Research, Development & Dissemination. As the Chief Research Officer he also oversees all of Research for Sutter Health that encompasses precision medicine, system level clinical trials, predictive analytics, population health management, and digital health technology solutions.
